Data are provided for each local section according to section size. To determine a section's size category, refer to the table below.

Section Size Category

Small	Fewer than 200 members
Medium Small	200-399 members
Medium	400-799 members
Medium Large	800-1,599 members
Large	1,600-3,199
Very Large	3,200 members and more

Note: In 1999, the Very Large size category was added. Prior to 1999, the Large size category included all local sections with 2000 or more members.

A. Administration

This section indicates the number of committees, subsections, and topical groups in the section. This section also indicates the number of section affiliates and the month the local section changes officers, as well as the amount of voluntary local section dues and the percentage of members who have paid dues.

B. Meetings

This section indicates the number of executive committee and section meetings. The percentage of members who attended section meetings is also listed.

C. Programs and Activities

This section indicates (Y for "Yes" and N for "No") the programs and activities that the local section held during the year.

D. Internal Communications

This section refers to the number of newsletters published and indicates whether or not the section conducted a membership survey.

E. Finances

This section indicates whether or not the section prepared a budget and gives information on section revenues, expenses, and net assets. The amount of the local section allotment is shown.

Each year, the ACS Council Committee on Local Section Activities (LSAC) recognizes local sections of the American Chemical Society that have made significant contributions to the welfare of their members and have obtained the public's awareness of the importance of the chemical profession.

By way of a detailed review process, LSAC assesses each section's activities, based on the section's annual report, and determines those sections that have exhibited exemplary performance. The committee then selects a winning section in each size category as well as several other sections within the same size category that have had a commendable year. The winning sections -- those sections that have demonstrated meritorious contribution to their members and to the chemical profession -- receive the "Outstanding Performance Award." The other selected finalists receive Certificates of Excellence. These awards and certificates are presented at the ACS fall national meeting each year.

The Council Committee on Local Section Activities and the Department of Local Section and Community Activities congratulates all winners and finalists of the "Outstanding Performance Awards."

Figure 1:Local Section Distribution by Section Size

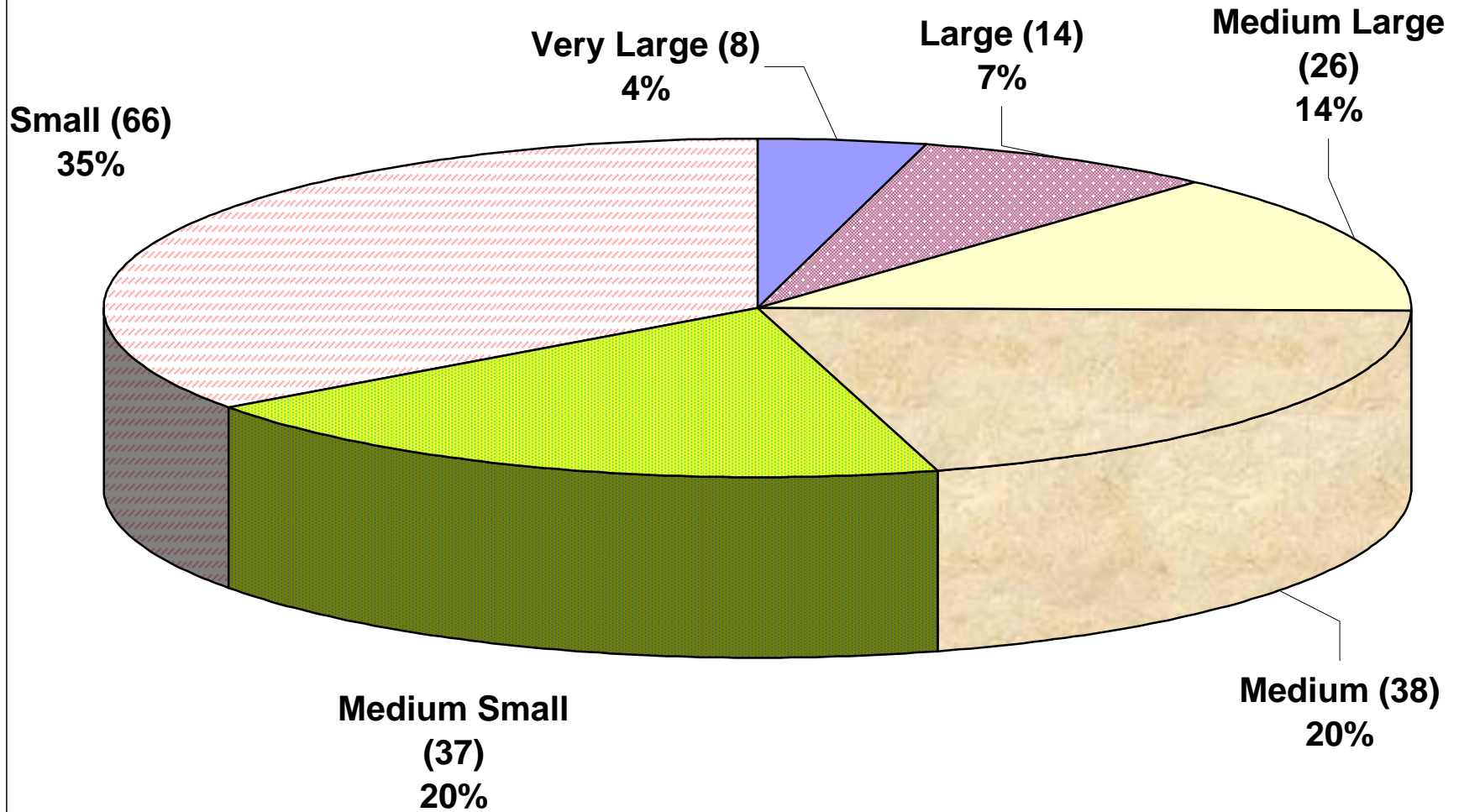


Figure 2: Membership Distribution by Size Category

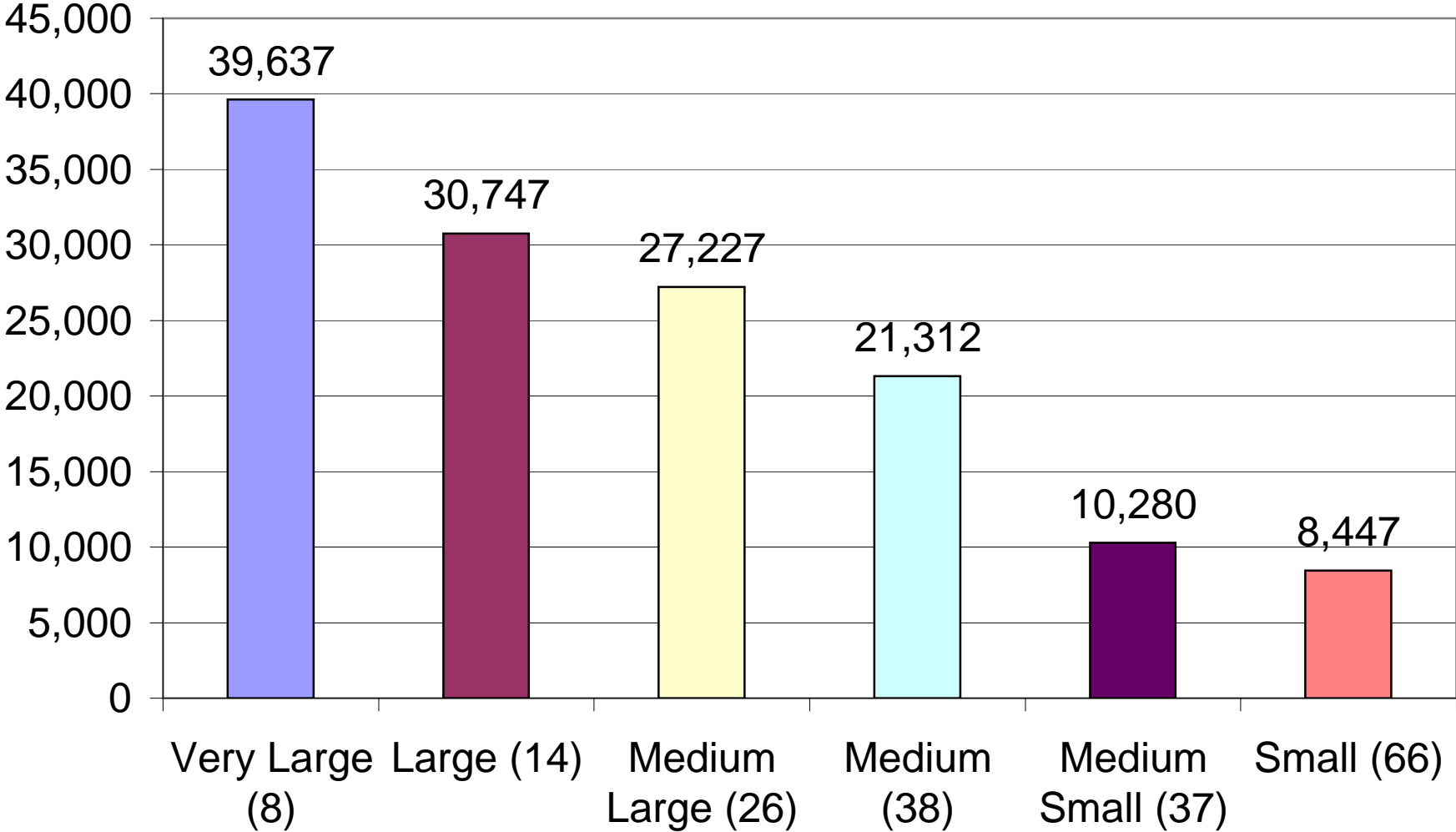


Figure 3: How Councilors Report Back to Local Section on National ACS Matters
